DIARRHEA IS A NON-SPECIFIC SYMPTOM WITH MANY DIFFERENT CAUSES:



- Stress caused by change in environment, diet or water supply
- Intestinal parasites or bacterial or viral intestinal infections
- Eating too many treats

Overall, the most important things to remember are:

1. Keep the ferret hydrated
2. Feed a soft-food diet
3. Give a high-calorie supplement

No matter the cause, if left untreated, diarrhea may lead to death due to poor nutrient absorption and dehydration.
